




important information for universal credit customers



step one – sign into your UC journal, from home screen, press to report a change



step two – go to where you live and what it costs



step three – your tenancy details will show here, you need to update to end your rent free weeks




step four – press something else and continue




step five – you may see a warning message appear about updating your annual rent increase. Your 'to do' list item to report your change in rent will not report your change to end rent free weeks




step six – what date did the change happen, enter 3 04 2023 and continue




step seven – confirm the number of bedrooms in your home




step eight – enter yes if there is more than yourself on the tenancy or no if the tenancy for your home is in your name only



step nine – enter the basic rent value and how often the rent is charged, this is usually weekly



step ten – press no, how many rent free weeks is now 0




step 11 – if your rent includes services charges that are usually paid as part of your housing costs, include the service charge value here. This is usually for homes with communal areas



step 12 – press yes if your name is on the council tax bill, unless this is a new tenancy you should press yes if you have applied or are in receipt of a council tax reduction



step 13 – this screen should summarise the entries you have made to report – check carefully



step 14 – press to submit the details or no to go back to change them
